The 2012 Amending Regulations on Gymnastics Private Schools, which have been adopted by the Cyprus Sports Organisation's Board of Administration on the basis of the articles 5(2)(ka) and 25 of the Cyprus Sports Organisation Law as approved by the Council of Ministers, after been submitted before the House of Representatives and been approved by it, they were published in the Official Journal of the Republic of Cyprus, in accordance with the article 3 subparagraph (3) of the (1989 L.99 as amended by the 1990 227 Law and 2010 3(i)) Law on the Regulations published by virtue of the Authorisation Law being submitted before the House of Representatives.

1. These Regulations shall be referred to as the 2012 Gymnastics Private Schools (amending) Regulations and they shall be read with the 1995 Regulations on the Gymnastics Private Schools (which shall be referred to hereinafter as the key regulations) and

3 Regulation

2. The key regulations 3 Regulation shall be amended by deleting its (2) paragraph and replacing it by the following revised one:

“(2)(a) Each person wishing to open and run a school should apply to the CSO, asking for a school operating permit to be issued. The kind of training offered by the school or the kind of sport to be exercised should be mentioned precisely in the application.

(b) The CSO shall examine the application and check whether the provisions of the article 13 of the Free Settling of Service Suppliers and the Free Movement of Services 2010 Law are fulfilled.

It is presumed that no matter the article 13 subparagraph (4) provisions, in case no response is given within the deadline as provided and or extended by virtue of the same article subparagraph (3), the permit shall be considered non-issued.”

3. paragraph (1) of the key regulations 13 Regulation shall be amended by deleting the sentence “The number of the trainers shall be determined by the CSO, depending on the number of trainees exercising a sport” and it shall be replaced by the following sentence:

“- The number of trainees exercising a sport per trainer supervising them shall be determined in accordance with the Annex.”

- <sup>i</sup> **Sports as a leisure activity:** Participating people take part in sport & physical activities aiming to improve physical, spiritual and psychological health.
- <sup>ii</sup> **Pre competitive & Competitive Sports:** Participating people take part in organized sport activities aiming to optimize and maximize their skills (technical, regular, physical, and their lifestyle and personal capacities), as well as their rivals participating in sport events
- <sup>iii</sup> **RESISTANCE GYMNASTICS** Upon registration of the person involved in sports and before such person performing any physical activity, a personal health card, the suitable physical program, as well as guidance for the correct use of any training equipment to be used in the context of the this program, should be required
- <sup>iv</sup> **PARENTAL CONSENT:** For those undergoing training who are younger than eighteen (18) years to accomplish registration, the written consent of the persons assuming parental responsibility in their favour is furthermore required.
